A Levels

A Levels consist of four modules. In the first year, two modules are taken at AS Level. In the second year (also known as A2) a further two modules will be taken for an A Level.

Brockenhurst College is one of only 30 places in the UK that offers the highly respected and recognised qualification as an alternative to A Levels. You will take 6 subjects during the 2 year course, giving you an unusual breadth of study.

BTEC National Diplomas and Certificates

BTEC National Diplomas are equivalent to 3 A Levels and National Certificates are equivalent to 2 A Levels. These qualifications are vocationally specific and designed to meet the needs of specialist individual industries. They also provide an excellent pathway to University.
