Qingdao has an unusual history. During the twentieth century, it was occupied by both Germany and Japan, both of whom have left indelible marks on the city's culture. It also boasts the largest Korean population in China.

Qingdao was host to the 2008 Olympic sailing events, and water sports of various kinds remain a popular pastime.

At the annual beer festival, tourists from all over China and beyond come to sample a huge range of drinks, food and entertainment, all within walking distance of the spectacular Golden Sands beach.

Mt. Lao lies just to the east of the city, offering a variety of walks, hikes and climbs, and some spectacular views of the coast.
