

British School Integration Programme

Anglo-Continental's School Integration Programme offers groups of students aged 11 – 16 years an exciting opportunity to experience life as a British school student. Students will participate fully in British life by studying English at Anglo-Continental followed by a placement in a state secondary school. During the British school integration, students will be following the school's British curriculum alongside their British buddies. Subjects studied may include English, Maths, Science, Geography, History, Technology, Religious Studies, German, French and Physical Education.

Carefully selected homestay accommodation is an established feature of this programme. All meals are included – lunch during the school week is taken at the schools.

Our partner school is a very successful joint church school which educates over 1,000 students on its campus in Poole. Daily door-to-door transport will be provided between the homestay and state secondary school.

- Lunch from Monday to Friday is taken at the school. The homestay family will provide a packed lunch for the excursion on Saturday. All other meals are taken with the homestay family.
- Special diets, except for vegetarian diet, will incur an extra charge of £25 per week and are subject to availability.

Transport

- Transport between homestay and state school included (5 return journeys).
- Door-to-door transport is compulsory for students aged 13 and under.

Please note

- English language lessons and sports/leisure activities may alternate between mornings and afternoons on a weekly basis.
- Depending on the timetable, students may attend the state school in weeks 1, 2 or 3.
- To comply with the state school safeguarding policy the group leader(s) are unable to shadow their students at the school. The school is happy to arrange for the group leader(s) to meet with their students at a pre-determined time and place.
